

## Getting to Ludwell Valley Park April 2017

Visitors to Ludwell Valley Park are strongly encouraged to use public transport, walk or cycle. On-street parking around the Valley Park entrances is very limited and the Park is well-served by local bus routes.

### Buses

For up-to-date and detailed information on local bus routes visit [www.stagecoachbus.com](http://www.stagecoachbus.com) or phone 01392 427711. The main local routes (correct at time of publication) are:

**Route D** University - City Centre – Digby. Alight in

- ✓ Lethbridge Road for Woodwater Lane entrance and
- ✓ Parkland Drive for Aspen Close and Parkland Drive entrances

**Route H** University – St David’s Station – City Centre – Royal Devon and Exeter Hospital – Digby. Alight in:

- ✓ Rifford Road for Wonford Playing Fields and Ludwell Lane entrances (approximately 5 minutes walk to the Valley Park from the bus stop)
- ✓ Woodwater Lane for Aspen Close entrance (approximately 5 minutes walk to the Valley Park from the bus stop opposite Lansdowne)

**Route R** City Centre – Rifford Centre – City Centre (circular clockwise) and **Route S** (circular anti-clockwise). Alight in

- ✓ Burnthouse Lane/Rifford Road for Wonford Playing Fields and Ludwell Lane entrances (*approximately 5 minutes walk to the Valley Park from the bus stop*)

**Routes K/J/T** Pinhoe – Whipton – City Centre – Countess Wear etc. Alight in:

- ✓ Topsham Road for Topsham Road entrance (opposite the cemetery entrance)

### Cycling

The higher fields of the Valley Park are not suitable for cycling. Cyclists are welcome to use the shared cycle/footpaths between Topsham Road and Ludwell Lane/ Woodwater Lane but please be considerate of pedestrians on these paths.

### Walking

You might be surprised how quickly you can reach Ludwell Valley Park on foot from Heavitree, Wonford, St Loyes & Countess Wear. Walking between Ludwell and the River Valley Park (across the Topsham Road by the cemetery) makes for a fantastic longer walk.

### Trains

- ✓ The nearest railway stations are Digby and Sowton and Newcourt, both of which are approximately a 20 minute walk to Ludwell Valley Park.
- ✓ From Exeter St David’s station, you can catch the H bus (see above) from outside the station.
- ✓ From Exeter Central Station, you can catch the D or H bus (see above) from outside the station
