2019 is going to be an exciting year for the park - more news soon!

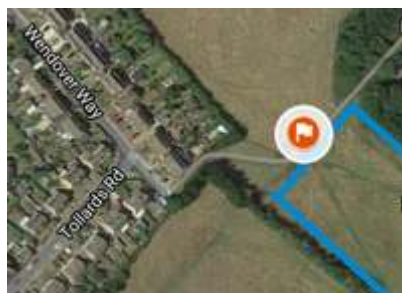
Community Orchard - come and be part of it!
